

Return to Sunday School and Worship: parking and entry plan

As we move back into our Sunday School spaces to engage in Bible Study and Worship, we ask that you please use the following information and map to navigate our facilities to allow for more social distancing to occur.

The Senior Adults in Classes A6, A7 Co-ed and the Faithful Workers are attending worship at 9am in the Sanctuary, will move to their classes at 10am. See directions at the bottom of the map.

Black arrows are for the Senior Adults using the 9am Worship Service.

Green arrows are for the Senior Adults using the 10am Sunday School.

Please park in the east parking lot near the office entrance or on South 20th street in front of the Sanctuary and offices.

Adult 6 will move out to the Family Center. Adult 7 Co-Ed will move to the Fellowship Hall. The Faithful Workers will remain in their room at 10am. These spaces will allow for more room to set the classes up for Social Distancing.

The remainder of our Sunday School Classes, Pre-School to Adult 5, will meet in their original Spaces at 9:15am for Bible Study and 10:30am for Worship. See directions at the top of the map. Families are asked to drop off their **Children** and check in their **Preschoolers** on the west side of the church behind the Sanctuary and **Youth** on the east side under the covered entry.

Purple arrows are for the Adults and Families to follow for the 9:15am Sunday School.

Red Arrows are for the Adults and Families to follow for the 10:30am Worship Service.

We will have a drop off area marked on the west side of our facilities so that parents can quickly park and bring their young children in and check them in before moving to a designated parking spot.

Families please pick your children up on your way to Worship at the north door of the children's hall. The preschool children will remain in their classrooms and you can pick them up at the north door after service. The south door of the Children's hall will be designated as an emergency exit only. This will provide some separation between our age groups.

Remember to wear your face covering while entering and moving about the church facilities. And where social distancing is more difficult. And please stay home if you or your family are sick or running a fever.

Our desire is to make our transition back as safe as we can, understanding an attitude of grace needs to lead the way, as we move into our facilities. We ask that our children in grades 1-12 follow the face covering, temperature and health check guidance of our Abilene schools.

Our hope is that soon all of our church family will be in Bible Study and Worship at the same times and in the same places as we were before the virus. We will continue to monitor and stay informed about best practices as we move forward. We appreciate your patience and the grace in which you are walking with us through these unprecedented times.
